Host institution

Doñana Biological Station (EBD) is a public research institute dedicated to the study of Ecology, Evolution and the Conservation of Biodiversity. It belongs to the Spanish National Research Council (CSIC) and it is located in Seville, a sunny and picturesque city with one of the largest historic centers in Europe.

Project

BURSTS focuses on the study of the diversification process of one of the world's largest groups of birds, the tyrant flycatchers and allies. This continental radiation spans the Americas and, despite its size and contribution to Neotropical avifauna, has been understudied from a macroevolutionary perspective. By evaluating the relative roles of geography, natural selection, and sexual selection in this exceptionally successful group, BURSTS aims to advance theory on adaptive radiations. The PhD candidate will analyze the evolution of two key traits (song and foraging strategy) and their importance in the family's diversification dynamics.

Eligibility

- Experience programming in the R environment and data analysis.
- Self-motivation, enthusiasm, good organizational skills, and the ability to work both independently and collaboratively.
